Application Customization Stockpile Dressta's crawler dozers have a stockpile compaction feature package that has been built to manage tricky job situations including sloped and unstable work environments. This SFR equipment has a heavy-duty Dressta steel drum along with a winch line attachment with brackets attached to the drum. The tensioning system prevents the line from touching the slope face. A cleaning system and precision guide are part of the machine. Fire Tractor Dozers This line of fire tractor dozers is perfect for containing, preventing and cleaning up after forest fires. Fire plows, bush blades and winches are some of the other pieces of equipment used to combat fires. Special features are implemented to prevent overheating

such as cooling modules for the powertrain, charge air and radiator and the direct drive powertrain. Belt Shifting Mining operations utilize conveyor belts to transport minerals and debris from the seam to reprocessing locations.
